8 Yard Residential Container Leasing

Residents wishing to lease a container for disposal of materials around their homes must call the Solid Waste Department at (972) 744-4111 to make a reservation. The fees will be charged to the resident's utility bill.

Effective March 1, 2010, the City will deliver the container to the resident's home and drop it into the driveway (**the container cannot be set on the street or in the alley**). A maximum of two weeks will be allowed to keep the container on your property. If the City of Richardson does not receive notice for cancellation of service prior to the two weeks, the City will automatically schedule the pickup of the container.

Restrictions:

- The container shall not be loaded with material that is hazardous (**toxic, corrosive, reactive, ignitable, radioactive, paint, oil, etc.**) or liquid.
- The container shall not be overloaded (**lids able to fully close on the container**). The Solid Waste department reserves the right to ask the resident (or contractor) to take debris out of the container if, in the City's opinion, the container is overloaded or contains prohibited materials.
- The material loaded onto the truck shall not exceed the length, height, or width of the container.
- Any loose material, such as rubble, rubbish, leaves, paper, or grass clippings, should be contained in a bag or box.
- The container may **not** be loaded with **shingles, dirt, rocks, concrete, bricks, ceramic tiles, etc.**
- The person leasing the container will be responsible for any breakage or damage to the vehicle.

Residential Opentop Container Leasing

Residents wishing to lease an opentop container for disposal of materials around their homes must call the Solid Waste Department at (972) 744-4111 to make a reservation. The fees will be charged to the resident's utility bill. **(Call for prices on the containers.)**

Rental Charges (Not including dump fees)

The 20 yard Opentop or the 30 yard Opentop containers carry a monthly rental charge after the two week grace period has expired. The monthly rental fee for the 20 yard Opentop is \$105.00. The monthly rental fee for the 30 yard Opentop is \$125.00. The monthly fees are in addition to any haul charges and are based on the initial set date only. Having the container emptied will not reset the monthly rental charge date. A one-time \$60.00 set fee will apply to the 20 yard and 30 yard Opentop containers.

The City will deliver the container to the resident's home and back it into the driveway (the container cannot be set on the street or in the alley). At the appointed time, the City will pick up the container and haul it to the transfer station.

Restrictions:

- Contractors can lease the opentops, only after they have opened an account with the City and filled out the necessary paper work.
- The container shall not be loaded with material that is hazardous (**toxic, corrosive, reactive, ignitable, radioactive, paint, oil, etc.**) or liquid.
- The container shall not be overloaded (**not over the sign that is on the container**). The Solid Waste department reserves the right to ask the resident (or contractor) to take debris out of the container if, in the City's opinion, the container is overloaded or contains prohibited materials.
- The material loaded onto the truck shall not exceed the length, height, or width of the container (**the tarp has to cover the container fully**).
- Any loose material, such as rubble, rubbish, leaves, paper, or grass clippings, should be contained in a bag or box.
- The container may **not** be loaded with **shingles, dirt, rocks, concrete, bricks, ceramic tiles, etc.**
- The person leasing the container will be responsible for any breakage or damage to the vehicle.
