Failure to Stop and Render Aid 900 Block N. Floyd Road Richardson, TX

On Thursday, July 14, 2011, at approximately 5:07 p.m., officers responded to the 900 block of N. Floyd Road on the report of an automobile colliding with a child. Upon arrival officers discovered that a black SUV type vehicle, possibly a Toyota 4-Runner, had left the roadway and struck a twelve year-old boy who had been operating an electric go-cart on the sidewalk in Heights Park. After striking the young man the operator of the vehicle did not stop. Instead she continued to travel through the park lawn before making a U-turn and exiting near where the victim had been initially struck. She was last seen travelling southbound on N. Floyd Road. She was described by witnesses as a middle aged white female with a white Maltese type dog in the vehicle.

The child victim suffered severe injuries as a result of the collision and was transported to Children's Medical Center in Dallas for treatment. He remains in the Intensive Care Unit.

Update: July 19, 2011

Richardson Police have arrested 62 year-old Richardson resident, Elaine Burbridge, as the operator of the vehicle that struck the 12 year-old child and fled the scene. Ms. Burbridge has been charged with Failure to Stop and Render Aid, a third degree felony.
