CHAPTER 13: MISCELLANEOUS OFFENSES AND PROVISIONS ARTICLE VI. PLANTS AND STRUCTURES ALONG STREETS, ALLEYS, ETC.

Sec. 13-141. Overhang of trees restricted; plantings in alleys.

(a) Trees shall be trimmed so as to avoid causing a hazard to public places. The minimum overhang shall be 7 feet above sidewalks, 9 feet at top of the street curb, 11 feet above the gutter line, and 14 feet above the street or alley surface at the outside edge of the parking lane.

(b) No planting of trees or tall shrubs will be permitted within alley rights-of-ways. Growth encroachment in the alley shall not exceed one foot. In areas where the dedicated right-of-way is enhanced by alley easements on either or both sides, the one foot maximum growth encroachment shall also be effective.
