# MEMO

## OPERATING HOURS CHANGE AT RPL

Since 1985, the Richardson Public Library has been open for 64 hours a week: M-F 10-9; Friday & Saturday 10-6; Sunday 2-6. Beginning February 11, 2019, the library will start opening at 9AM Monday through Thursday, increasing our hours to 68 a week. This change will be in line with other cities in the area.

This addition to service hours is in response to several things. In the formulation of the library's most recent Strategic Plan, citizen input indicated a desire to see the library open earlier during the work week. Indeed, this became a part of the final plan:

"Consider adjusting the number of hours open for service and offer new program times and topics, in line with patron interests and expectations."

Another determining factor is the most recent *Texas Public Library Standards (2014)* put forth by the Texas State Library and Texas Library Association which delineates best practices for the libraries in Texas based on population size. For libraries serving over 100,000 people, the standard for "enhanced" service (or 50<sup>th</sup> percentile) in accessibility/hours open is 64. To be considered "exemplary (75<sup>th</sup> percentile) we would need to be open 68 hours a week.

In the last revision of Article II/Library Board, Section 11-31 was modified to read:

"It shall study and encourage the development of exemplary library facilities for the residents of the city."

Always striving to be exemplary in all services, the Richardson Public Library would like to make this change. It will have no budgetary implications – no additional staff or staffing hours are necessary. This change will simply be a matter of adjusting staff schedules. The leadership team of RPL has spent several months preparing appropriate schedules and considering all implications for programming, accessibility, and marketing.

On January 9, 2019, the Library Board discussed the proposed additional hours, and unanimously recommended council approval.





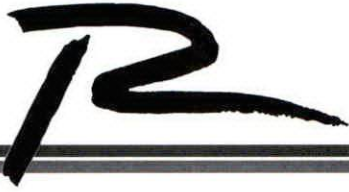
