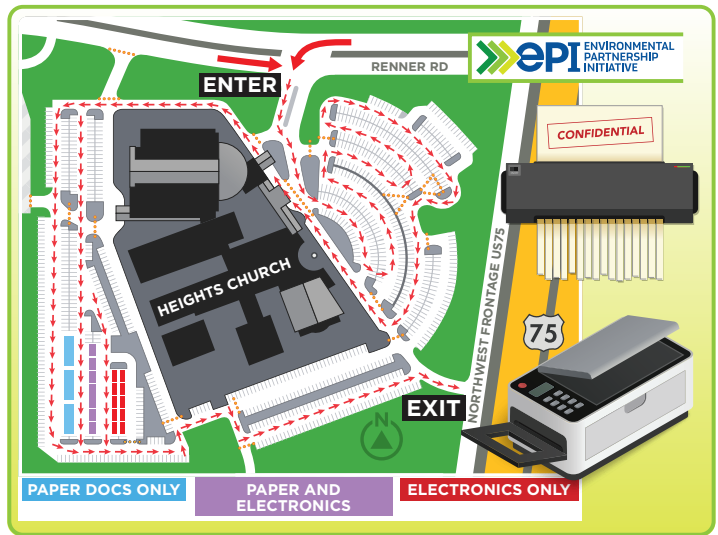
ELECTRONICS RECYCLING AND DOCUMENT SHREDDING SCHEDULED FOR MAY 9 FROM 10 A.M.-2 P.M. AT THE HEIGHTS CHURCH

The Richardson Citizen Police Academy Alumni Association's (RCPAAA) spring Electronics Recycling and Document Shredding Event will be held on Saturday, May 9 from 10 a.m.-2 p.m. at The Heights Church, 201 W. Renner Rd. (southwest corner of Renner Road and US 75). Drop off documents and electronic devices (cell phones, flat screen TVs or monitors, peripherals, etc.) to be recycled or shredded. There is no charge for dropping off electronics and five boxes or less of paper (banker's box size) however there will be a minimum \$5 charge per box more than five boxes. For a

Note: Please bring only sensitive documents to be shredded. Papers such as magazines or newspapers can be placed in regular recycling.
